LITTLE AND TINY MISS NORTHWEST 2010

Official Rules and Regulations

1. Contestants must be a Missouri resident.
2. Contestants must be ages 3-5 to compete in the Tiny Miss competition on the day of the pageant.
3. Contestants must be ages 6-8 to compete in the Little Miss competition on the day of the pageant.
4. The winner will be eligible to compete at the Misses of Missouri Pageant to be held in July, 2010.
5. The First Runner up will be eligible to compete at the Missouri Sweethearts Pageant to be held in July, 2010.
6. Winners and 1st runners-up must remain Missouri residents to be eligible to compete in July. If winners and runners-up move out of state, they will not be eligible to compete.
7. Remember that sportsmanship and fun are the primary goal of the competition.

Phases of Competition

1. Fitness Wear- This should be something that contestants play in, wear while participating in sports and can include cheerleading outfits, tennis wear, soccer or softball uniforms or even swimwear, if on a swim team and is one-piece swimwear. If you are unsure of what to wear, please call Pat Wyatt 660-582-6880.
2. Optional Talent Competition-This phase will be completed before formalwear.
3. Formal wear or Party wear- This should be something worn to church, a formal party, wedding or event. This will be very subjective and both floor length and short dresses may be chosen. Age appropriateness is the primary key.
4. Onstage Question-This phase will be conducted in Formalwear before leaving the stage.
5. Optional Photogenic competition will be judged prior to the pageant by outside judges.
